**1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).**

The art teacher at Tenaya was on a leave of absence August through December. PROP 28 arts funds were utilized to provide students exposure to Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA) through programs with traveling artists in drama, visual arts, STEAM, and spoken word. In addition these funds were used to purchase art supplies and fund field trips to performing arts performances and museums. At the high school level, arts education was sustained with offerings in music, drama, and art at Tioga, and drama, art, and Culinary Arts at Don Pedro. This adjustment ensured that high needs students continued to receive a diverse arts education, albeit through modified means.
